CPR & First Aid

Who is this for?

- Members whose First Aid certification has expired, is about to expire, or who do not currently hold a First Aid award.

What you'll gain

- HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and HLTAID011 - Provide First Aid



Time commitment

- 3 hours of self-directed online theory modules and questions
- 4 hours of face-to-face practical training

CPR & Advanced Resuscitation Techniques

Who is this for?

- Members who currently hold a First Aid (HLTAID011) or
- Members who hold the older ART HLTAID007 & have a current First Aid (HLTAID011) award.

What you'll gain

- HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and HLTAID015 - Provide advanced resuscitation and oxygen therapy (ART)



Time commitment

- 3 hours of self-directed online theory modules and questions
- 4 hours of face-to-face practical training

CPR, First Aid & Advanced Resuscitation Techniques

Who is this for?

- Members who do not hold either a current First Aid award (HLTAID011) or ART (HLTAID015)

What you'll gain

- HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- HLTAID011 - Provide First Aid
- HLTAID015 - Provide advanced resuscitation and oxygen therapy (ART)



Time commitment

- 6 hours of self-directed online theory modules and questions
- 7 hours of face-to-face practical training

The above times are approximate; you may require more or less time depending on your prior knowledge

- To participate in the practical session, you must complete **all online theory** for the course in advance.
 - This is done in aXcelerate, you will be given access upon successful enrolment.

To enrol into any course, you will need your **Unique Student Identifier (USI)** number. A USI is an individual education number that's assigned to you for life by the Australian Government. If you don't have one It's free and will take about 5 minutes to complete the process - you will need at least one form of valid identification.
